CANCELLATION FEES: Up to 100 days prior to departure date June 25, 2017, a \$150.00 cancellation fee. From 99 to 61 days prior to departure date, by August 2, 2017, a \$400.00 cancellation fee. From 60 to 45 days prior to departure date -August 28, 2017, a \$1,000.00 cancellation fee. From 45 days prior to departure date, Saturday, August 19, 2017, and on – the full tour price is the cancellation fee (100%)

AIR PACKAGE INCLUDES: Round trip airfare from San Diego, Dallas or New York to Tel Aviv. All air rates and schedules are subject to change prior to ticketing.
