From 60 to 45 days prior to departure date, a \$1,000.00 cancellation fee. From 45 days prior to departure date and on – full cancellation fee (100%)

**AIR PACKAGE INCLUDES:** Round trip airfare from San Diego, Los Angeles or New York, to Tel Aviv. All air rates and schedules are subject to change prior to ticketing. Additional airport gateways are available on and individual basis. Call for individual prices and air itineraries. There is a \$250 fee for changing the passengers name after ticketing or the flight schedule once the passenger is ticketed.
